## A BILL

To require the Secretary of Veterans Affairs to formally recognize caregivers of veterans, notify veterans and caregivers of clinical determinations relating to eligibility for caregiver programs, and temporarily extend benefits for veterans who are determined ineligible for the family caregiver program, and for other purposes.

1	Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2	tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
3	SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
4	This Act may be cited as the "Transparency and Ef-
5	fective Accountability Measures for Veteran Caregivers
6	Act" or the "TEAM Veteran Caregivers Act".
7	SEC. 2. MODIFICATION OF ADMINISTRATION OF CARE-
8	GIVER PROGRAM OF DEPARTMENT OF VET-
9	ERANS AFFAIRS.
10	(a) Official Designation of Caregivers.—
11	(1) In General.—The Secretary of Veterans
12	Affairs shall formally recognize all earegivers of vet-
13	erans by identifying any caregiver of a veteran in
14	the health record of the veteran.
15	(2) Inclusion. Caregivers recognized under
16	paragraph (1) shall include—
17	(A) family caregivers participating in the
18	program of comprehensive assistance for family
19	caregivers under subsection (a) of section
20	1720G of title 38, United States Code; and
21	(B) caregivers participating in the program
22	of support services for caregivers under sub-
23	section (b) of such section.
24	(b) Notification Letters Regarding Clinical
25	DETERMINATIONS.—

(1) In General.—The Secretary, using a
standardized letter, shall notify veterans and care-
givers of veterans regarding any clinical determina-
tions made relating to claims under, or eligibility for,
a caregiver program under subsection (a) or (b) of
section 1720G of title 38, United States Code.
(2) Elements.—Notifications under paragraph

- (2) ELEMENTS.—Notifications under paragraph
  (1) shall include the elements required for notices of
  decisions under section 5104(b) of title 38, United
  States Code, to the extent that those elements apply
  to claims or eligibility determinations under paragraph (1).
- 13 (c) Temporary Extension of Benefits for Fam-14 hy Caregiver Program.—
  - (1) In GENERAL. Upon determining that a veteran who was receiving services under the program of comprehensive assistance for family caregivers under section 1720G(a) of title 38, United States Code, is no longer clinically eligible for purposes of such program, the Secretary shall extend benefits under such program, including stipends under paragraph (3)(A)(ii)(V) of such section, for not less than 90 days after the date of notification under subsection (b) that the veteran is no longer clinically eligible.

1	(2) Exclusion.—Paragraph (1) shall not apply
2	to the termination of earegiver benefits—
3	(A) for cause, including—
4	(i) noncompliance with requirements
5	of the program; or
6	(ii) fraud;
7	(B) because the veteran died; or
8	(C) upon request of the caregiver or the
9	<del>veteran.</del>

11	This Act may be cited as the "Transparency and Effec-

14	SEC. 2. MODIFICATION OF ADMINISTRATION OF CAREGIVER
15	PROGRAMS OF DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS
16	AFFAIRS.
17	(a) Official Designation of Caregivers.—
18	(1) In General.—The Secretary of Veterans Af-
19	fairs, when determined feasible by the Secretary, shall
20	formally recognize all caregivers of veterans by identi-
21	fying any caregiver of a veteran in the electronic
22	health record of the veteran.
23	(2) Inclusion.—Caregivers recognized under
24	paragraph (1) shall include—

1	(A) any family caregiver who is approved
2	as a provider of personal care services for an eli-
3	gible veteran under the program of comprehen-
4	sive assistance for family caregivers under sub-
5	section (a) of section 1720G of title 38, United
6	States Code; and
7	(B) any caregiver of a covered veteran par-
8	ticipating in the program of support services for
9	caregivers under subsection (b) of such section.
10	(b) Standardized Letters Regarding Certain
11	Determinations Under Family Caregiver Pro-
12	GRAM.—
13	Section 1720G(a) of title 38, United States Code,
14	is amended by adding at the end the following new
15	paragraph:
16	"(12)(A) The Secretary shall notify the individuals de-
17	scribed in subparagraph (B) regarding decisions affecting
18	the furnishing of assistance under this subsection using
19	standardized letters, as the Secretary determines such noti-
20	fications and letters to be appropriate.
21	"(B) The individuals described in this subparagraph
22	shall include—
23	"(i) an individual who submits an application
24	for the program required by paragraph (1);

1	"(ii) an individual determined by the Secretary
2	to be an eligible veteran pursuant to such an applica-
3	tion; and
4	"(iii) a family caregiver of an eligible veteran
5	who is—
6	"(I) approved as a provider of personal care
7	services under paragraph $(6)(B)$ ; or
8	"(II) designated as a primary provider of
9	personal care services under paragraph (7)(A).".
10	(c) Temporary Extension of Benefits for Family
11	Caregiver Program.—Upon determining that a veteran
12	who was receiving services under the program of com-
13	prehensive assistance for family caregivers under section
14	1720G(a) of title 38, United States Code, is no longer clini-
15	cally eligible for purposes of such program, the Secretary
16	shall extend benefits under such program, including sti-
17	pends under paragraph (3)(A)(ii)(V) of such section, for a
18	period of time determined by the Secretary if such an exten-
19	sion is determined appropriate by the Secretary.
