I am writing to request the Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) act to award the new Lewistown Community Based Outpatient Clinic (CBOC) lease and continue aggressive oversight of the construction process so this facility can open to serve Fergus County-area veterans as soon as possible. I have long worked with Montana veterans, local communities, and VA to upgrade and modernize facilities across the Treasure State so veterans are able to receive timely, high-quality health care closer to where they live. This new Lewistown CBOC is critical because of its role in expanding access to VA health care for rural veterans in central Montana.
